# Bulk Water Fill Station Water Use Permit

Public Utility District No. 1 of Skagit County (District) authorizes the undersigned to establish a customer account to pay for, and obtain water from the District’s designated Bulk Water Filling Stations in accordance with the terms and conditions stated herein and in conformance with District Policy.

This Permit authorizes the applicant to withdraw water from the District’s Bulk Water Filling Stations. The withdrawal of District water from any other District water supply source, pipeline, or related facility is not permitted or authorized through this Permit and will result in revocation of this authorization. Water withdrawn from the District’s system without prior authorization is a criminal act and punishable under Federal and State Laws.

Bulk Water Filling Stations are dispensaries of District water that are activated through a prepaid card supplied by the District for authorized use. Locations of Bulk Water Filling Stations may be verified by contacting the District at (360)424-7104 or on the District’s website at [www.SkagitPUD.org](http://www.SkagitPUD.org).

**Water provided by fill stations after passing the meter is not warranted by the District as suitable for domestic/potable use.**

Use of fill station water is provided at the District's discretion to retail service area customers subject to availability, impact to system operations, and other relevant factors as determined by the District.

At the District's discretion, the provision of fill station water may be discontinued, moved to more appropriate site(s), or, allocated in a manner to achieve the equitable distribution and use of such water among all customers/potential user categories.

**Water provided by fill stations must be beneficially used within the approved service area of the District.**

Non-compliance with the terms/conditions of a fill station application may result in revocation of fill station approval and/or denial of future access.

District charges include a one-time account setup fee and consumptive use charges as described in the most current version of Appendix A in the District Water Policy Manual.

The District may suspend or terminate access to fill station facilities if their operation is determined to compromise and/or adversely impact District water system sources, operations, facilities, and/or direct water service obligations.

Issuance of this authorization is solely for the Applicant's use. No authorization has been granted for any other individual or organization other than the applicant to withdraw water under this application.

Issuance of this Permit is subject to providing satisfactory evidence of an approved filling mechanism such as an air gap, reduced pressure backflow assembly, or equivalent protective device, which is required to be used when filling the water tank/container.

Issuance of this Permit is subject to compliance with all terms and conditions of the District's Bulk Water Fill Stations Policy (*Water Policy Manual* Section 2.9), other applicable District policies, and state, local, and federal laws, ordinances, and regulations.

In exchange for permission to operate and obtain water from the Bulk Water Fill Station, the Applicant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the District and its officers, directors, employees, and agents from and against all claims, costs, losses, and damages, including, but not limited to attorney and other professional fees arising out of, connected with, or resulting from, the connection to the Bulk Water Filling Station, and the use of the water therefrom covered by this authorization.
