Skagit PUD hereby solicits Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from firms possessing the required experience and resources needed for Legal Services and Technical Consultation in the areas of water rights and environmental permitting.

SOQ must clearly demonstrate the ability of the respondent firm in the following evaluation factors: Overview of Firm, Proximity to Skagit County, Firm Experience in the areas requested, Staff Qualifications, Past Performance, and Fees.

Skagit PUD's Personal Services Rosters shall consist of all responsible firms that have submitted the necessary SOQ to be on the roster. Responsible firms may be added at any time. SOQ will be kept on file for calendar year 2023, or longer at Skagit PUD's discretion. If Skagit PUD develops potential scopes of work, the existing roster will be evaluated in accordance with Skagit PUD procurement practices. This is not a Request for Proposals.
